St Theresa Of Lisieux

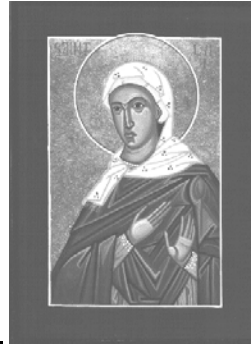
"Little Flower"

Saint Lydia was the Apostle Paul's first convert at Philippi.

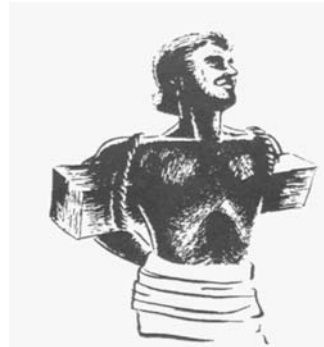
She was baptized with her household
